It should never surprise us when we discover how God works in the lives of His people, yet at Blue Letter Bible we are continually amazed at His divine providence. 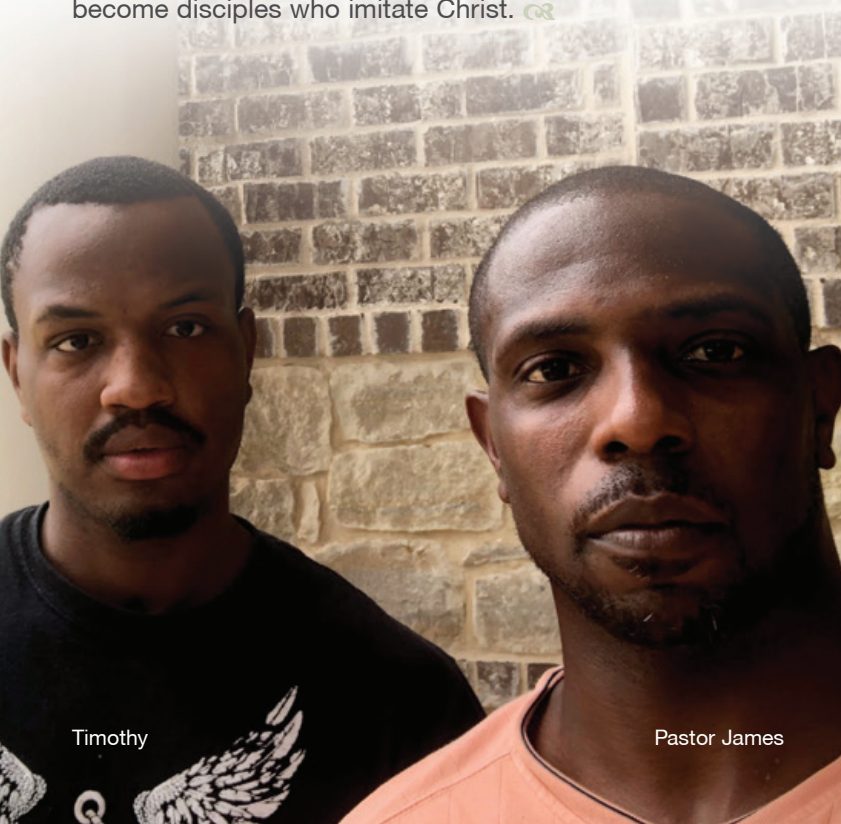
"I can't read."

## STAFF TIP Speed Up Your Bible Search

Not a very good speller? I can relate. Frequently, I want to jump right to a piece of Scripture and not hassle with my fumbling fingers. When searching for Scripture, did you know that you do not have to spell out the entire name of the book in a Bible reference? We have provided shortcuts to help reduce the amount of typing, and to alleviate spelling difficulties.



Instead of typing out Ezekiel 3, try ez3, or for 1 Thessalonians 5:5, try 1th5:5. We are not sensitive about letter casing either. This feature may seem trivial, but it really speeds-up jumping to multiple Scriptures during a Bible study or church service. And these shortcuts also work very nicely in our BLB mobile apps for iOS and Android. – Dan Davis, lead web developer since 2001.

### From Don Perkins – A chronological look at prophecy through the Scriptures

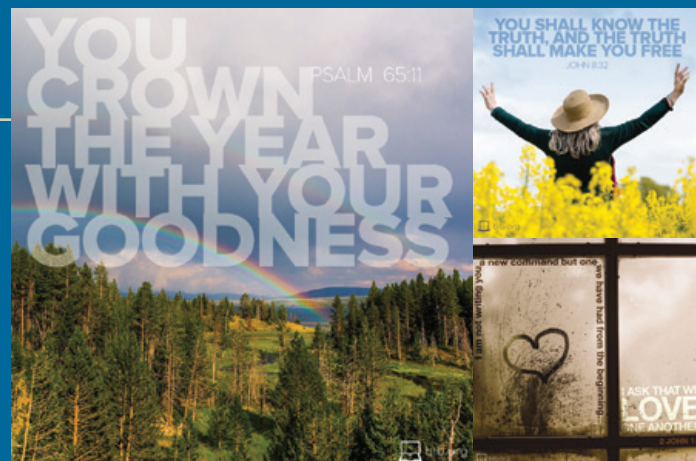

As people check their news feed, you can use these images to remind them that our hope is in heaven, and not in the things of this world.

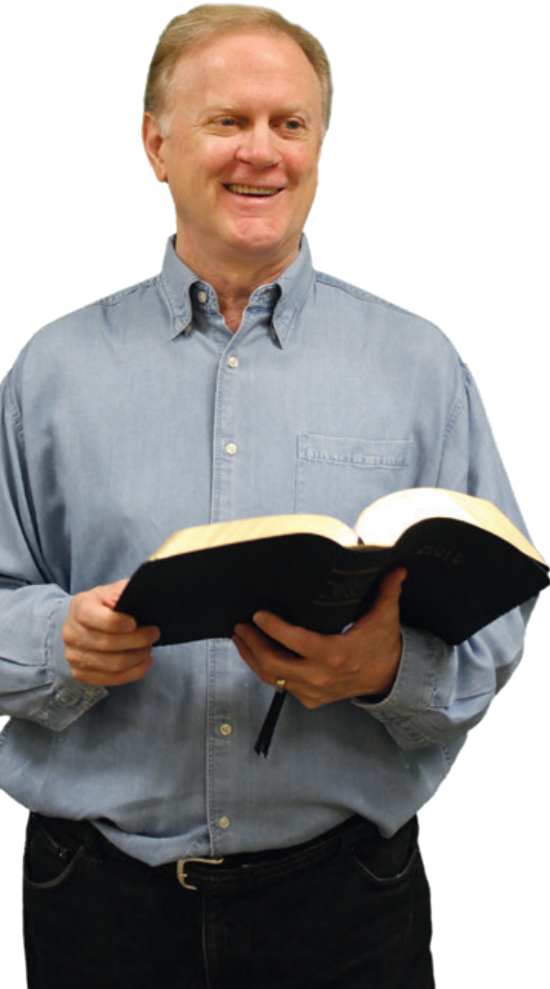
