

Scriptural proof that Jesus died on a cross

We agree Jesus died on a tree; the question is did the tree have a crossbeam. Checking the next few scriptures we can see the tree Jesus died on *did indeed have a crossbeam*. Therefore known as a *cross* rather than a *stake*.

24 But Thomas, one of the twelve, called Didymus, was not with them when Jesus came. **25** The other disciples therefore said unto him, We have seen the Lord. But he said unto them, Except I shall see in his hands the print of the nails, and put my finger into the print of the nails, and thrust my hand into his side, I will not believe.

John 20:25 Print of *nails*.

If Jesus died on a stake there would be one nail.

18 Verily, verily, I say unto thee, When thou wast young, thou girdedst thyself, and walkedst whither thou wouldest: but when thou shalt be old, thou shalt stretch forth thy hands, and another shall gird thee, and carry *thee* whither thou wouldest not. **19** This spake he, signifying by what death he should glorify God. And when he had spoken this, he saith unto him, Follow me.

John 21:18, 19 Jesus fortells the manner in which Peter will die. (Outstretched hands), he died on a cross upside down.

they watched him there; **37** And set up over his head his accusation written, This Is Jesus the King of the Jews.

Matt. 27:37 The sign was put over Jesus' *head*. If he had died on a stake the sign would be put over his hands.

38 Then were there two thieves crucified with him, one on the right hand, and another on the left. **39** And they that passed by reviled him, wagging their heads, **40** And saying, Thou that destroyest the temple, and buildest *it* in three days, save thyself. If thou be the Son of God, come down from the cross.

27 And with him they crucify two thieves; the one on his right hand, and the other on his left. **28** And the scripture was fulfilled, which saith, And he was numbered with the transgressors. **29** And they that passed by railed on him, wagging their heads, and saying, Ah,

Mark 15:27 The thieves were located on his *right hand* and his *left hand*. If he died on a stake it would have said his right and left *side*.
